

Dear Ms. Scott,

Thank you for providing the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) with a notice of hearing for the above referenced project, which calls for the construction of a new generating facility and associated transmission line near Arlington, Arizona. Duke Energy is applying for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility from the Arizona Corporation Commission. I have reviewed the documentation submitted and offer the following comments about the project, pursuant to the State Historic Preservation Act (A.R.S. § 41-861 to 41-864).

A review of our records indicates that the subject property has not been previously surveyed for cultural resources. However, based upon the results of nearby archaeological inventories, it is likely that historic and/or prehistoric archaeological sites are likely to be present.

It is our recommendation that the entire subject property be surveyed by a qualified cultural resource specialist in order to locate and evaluate any cultural remains that may be present. Once the survey has been completed, a copy of the report should be sent to this office for review and comment. If prehistoric or historic sites are identified within the project area, this office may recommend that archaeological testing be performed at the sites to evaluate their eligibility for the National or State Register of Historic Places. If Register eligible properties cannot be avoided by development activities entailed as a result of rezoning, this office may further recommend that a data recovery (excavation) program be implemented.

If a the project will involve other state or federal agencies by way of funding, permitting, or otherwise (e.g., a Section 404 permit from the Army Corp of Engineers, an NPDES permit from the Environmental Protection Agency, land use/access permits from Arizona State Land Department or the Bureau of Land Management), we strongly recommend that the applicant contact the appropriate state or federal agency for information about projects that may involve cultural
