Any person may make a limited appearance at the hearing by filing a statement in Ariting with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Phoenix, Arizona 85017, not less than five (5) days before the date set for hearing. A person making a limited appearance snall not be party or have the right to present testimony or Cross-canmine witnesses.

The written decision of the Commission shall be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 40-360.07. Any person in-tending to be 4 party before the Commission must be a party to the certification proceedings.
