Dear Corporation Commission:

I am aware that APS has contacted the Corporation Commission for a periodic rate review.

This letter is to bring your attention to the power extension costs that are currently in place. Presently APS will bring power 1,000 feet for free, then so much per foot up to 2,000 feet. The problem is the current \$25,000 cap on the extension. Property owners are lucky to go 2,000 feet, let alone turn a corner and stay under \$25,000.

Furthermore, if APS figures an extension will run over \$25,000, the property owner has to pay for the total cost of the extension. Even the 1,000 feet, which would otherwise be no cost to the property owner. What a deal! The \$25,000 cap makes it very difficult or impossible for the average person to extend power to his home.

Please look closely at the current \$25,000 cap. This current cap is approximately 25 years old, and grossly outdated for today's standards. I am willing to come to one of your meetings on this matter if necessary.
