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PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 27, 2003, the Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") and application for a rate increase and for approval of purchased power contract.

On July 25, 2003, the Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") of the Commission filed a letter stating that the application was found sufficient and classified the applicant as a Class A utility.

On August 14, 2003, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO, CLC, Local Unions 387, 640 and 769 (collectively, "IBEW") filed an application to intervene.

On August 15, 2003, the Arizona Cogeneration Association ("ACA") filed a request to intervene.

On August 19, 2003, Panda Gila River, L.P. ("Gila River") filed an application to intervene.

No objections have been filed and accordingly, the applications to intervene filed by IBEW, ACA and Gila River should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that IBEW, ACA and Gila River are hereby granted intervention in the above-captioned matter.

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
