15 Arizona Water Company, an Arizona corporation ("AWC"), pursuant to A.A.C.
 16 R14-3-105, moves to intervene in the above-captioned matter. This application is based
 17 upon the following:

18 1. AWC presently holds certificates of convenience and necessity issued to it
 19 by the Commission in various Decisions for the purpose of engaging in, and is now
 20 engaged in providing water utility service to customers located in Ajo Heights, Apache
 21 Junction, Bisbee, Casa Grande, Coolidge, Lakeside, Miami, Oracle, Overgaard,
 22 Pinewood, Rimrock, San Manuel, Sedona, Sierra Vista, Stanfield, Superior, White Tank,
 23 Winkelman, and other unincorporated areas within the State of Arizona.

24 2. AWC purchases electric power from Arizona Public Service Company that
 25 it uses to produce water to serve its customers in the majority of the cities, towns and
 26 communities listed in the preceding paragraph. Electric power is one of AWC's largest
 27 operating and maintenance expenses. For these reasons, AWC is directly and

1 substantially affected by the decision of the Commission in these proceedings. Granting
2 AWC intervention will not unduly broaden the issues presented by the Application and,
3 therefore, AWC is entitled to intervention pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105.

4 WHEREFORE, Arizona Water Company respectfully requests that it be granted
5 intervention in the above-referenced matter.
