



NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE COMPETITIVE RESOLD INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES AND ALTERNATE OPERATOR SERVICES ("AOS") BY OCMC, INC. (Applicant) has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for transfer of Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificates") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services and alternate operator services ("AOS") in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the Commission to provide these services under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the Commission. A.R.S. § 40-282 provides that the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing, if one is requested by any party. Applicant or any other party must request a hearing within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice, or the Commission will rule on the application without a hearing. The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exception to the Staff report prepared by the applicant are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, and at Applicant, OCMC, Inc., One Call Communications, 801 Congressional Boulevard, Suite 100, Carmel, Indiana 46032. Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings, and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with the A.A.C.R. 14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice. You may have the right to intervene in the proceedings, or you may make a statement for the record.
