PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On May 16, 2003, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 65923 in the above-captioned matter. As part of the Decision, the Commission ordered that a public comment hearing be scheduled regarding a proposed rule making to amend A.A.C. R14-2-1107 ("Rule 1107"). Rule 1107 currently governs the discontinuance of service or abandonment of service area by a telecommunications company providing competitive local exchange service. The proposed amendment to Rule 1107 would hold providers of resold or facilities-based interexchange service to the same requirements as local exchange service providers when discontinuing service or abandoning service area. This Procedural Order establishes a hearing schedule and orders publication of the proposed rule amendment, pursuant to the direction of Decision No. 65923.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a public comment hearing on the above-captioned matter shall be held on August 19, 2003 at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Utilities Division shall cause timely notice of the proposed rulemaking to be published in the Arizona Administrative Register.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, although comments in this matter will be taken through August 19, 2003, companies or other interested persons are requested to file written comments with the Commission's docket control center on the proposed rule amendment on or before June 27, 2003.
