AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. (AT&T) and TCG Phoenix (TCG) each have Commission-approved interconnection agreements with Qwest in the state of Arizona. AT&T and TCG each hereby adopt the Arizona QPAP effective as of December 15, 2003.


The Arizona Corporation Commission determined that "CLECs with Commission-approved interconnection agreements may opt into the terms of the approved Qwest Performance Assurance Plan by filing written notice of their intent to do so and do not require further Commission approval of interconnection agreement amendments." Page 36, Decision No. 64888, dated June 5 2002, *In the Matter of U.S. West Communications, Inc.'s compliance with Section 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996*. This letter shall serve as such notice. As determined by the Commission, this adoption does not require an amendment to the interconnection agreements.

In addition, the FCC's approval of Qwest's Arizona 271 application was effective on December 15, 2003. FCC 03-309, Released December 3, 2003, *In the Matter of Application by Qwest Communications International Inc., for Authorization to Provide In-Region, InterLATA Services in Arizona*. Pursuant to Section 13.1 of the Arizona QPAP, this is the date upon which the Arizona QPAP first became available to CLECs in Arizona. This is the basis for the December 15, 2003 effective date of this adoption.
