PROCEDURAL ORDER

Respondent.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 5, 2003, Roger and Darlene Chantel ("Complainants") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a complaint against Mohave Electric Cooperative ("Mohave") alleging that Mohave has violated several rules and regulations of the Commission.

On July 2, 2003, Mohave filed a request for an extension of time to file its response.

On July 14, 2003, Mohave filed a response to the complaint and a Motion to Dismiss.

A Procedural Order was issued on July 24, 2003 setting a Pre-Hearing Conference for August 19, 2003 for the purpose of defining the issues, discussing the procedures that will govern this matter and to set a hearing date.

On August 6, 2003, Mr. Chantel and counsel for Mohave jointly contacted the Hearing Division to request that the Pre-Hearing Conference be continued to September 4, 2003 due to scheduling conflicts.

On August 7, 2003, by Procedural Order, the pre-hearing was continued until September 4, 2003, and on September 4, 2003, pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was held. The Complainants appeared on their own behalf and the Respondent appeared through counsel. Respondent's Motion to Dismiss was considered and denied.

1 At the Procedural Conference, the parties stated that they had not reached a settlement on the
2 issues raised in the Complaint, but that they would meet and attempt to narrow the issues for hearing.

3 Consequently, this matter should be set for hearing.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a hearing shall commence in this matter on **October 27,**
5 **2003 at 10:30 a.m.,** at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall exchange witness lists and copies of any
7 exhibits that they intend to introduce at the hearing not later than **October 17, 2003.** Courtesy copies
8 of the witness lists and exhibits shall also be provided to the presiding Administrative Law Judge in
9 the proceeding by the aforementioned date.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall prepare at least four copies of any exhibit
11 that they intend to introduce into evidence at the hearing, unless a copy has previously been provided
12 to the opposing party and the Administrative Law Judge in which case they will need only two
13 copies, one for themselves and one for the official record of the proceeding.


