

2. Please provide the date on which the preliminary engineering specifications were submitted to ADEQ for review and approval.
3. Please provide the final and complete engineering specifications when they become available.
4. Please provide copies of the written requests for service from the property owners in the proposed extension areas.

Per Arizona Administrative Code upon meeting sufficiency requirements, the Commission has 150 calendar days for its substantive review. This includes conducting a hearing and preparing a proposed Opinion and Order to present to the Commission at an Open Meeting.


