On November 8, 2002, Arizona Utility Supply & Services, LLC ("Applicant") filed an application to transfer a portion of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to Johnson Utilities, L.L.C. If the application is granted, Johnson Utilities, L.L.C. ("Johnson") would be the provider of wastewater service to the following portion of the Applicant's service territory: Section 22 of Township 2 South of Range 8 East. The area sought to be transferred to Johnson is generally located one mile north of Combs Road, bounded on the east by Schneff Road and south of Rittenhouse Auxiliary Airfield.

The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona and at the Applicant's offices, 2875 W. Houston Ave. #400, Apache Junction, AZ 85220 (602)795-7980.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning **July 16, 2004, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's office, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken at the commencement of the hearing.

As a property owner or customer you may have the right to intervene in the proceeding and request a hearing. If you do not want to intervene, you may make oral or written comments by contacting the Commission at the above addresses. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written notice to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to the Applicant or their counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum, shall contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicants, a shareholder or member of the Applicants, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before July 9, 2004. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.
