PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 6, 2004, Rancho Cabrillo Water Company ("RCWC"), Rancho Cabrillo Sewer Company ("RCSC"), and Arizona-American Water Company ("Arizona-American"), through its Agua Fria Water District and through its Anthem/Agua Fria Wastewater District (collectively, "Applicants") jointly filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to transfer RCWC's and RCSC's Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&Ns") to Arizona-American. The application also requested an extension of Arizona-American's service territory under its existing CC&Ns for the Agua Fria Water District and its Anthem/Agua Fria Wastewater District.

On February 24, 2004, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a letter informing Applicants that the application is administratively complete.

On February 25, 2004, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled for May 20, 2004 at 9:30 a.m.

On May 13, 2004, Staff filed a Notice of Staff Witness Scheduling Conflict stating that Staff's witness is scheduled to appear in two hearings scheduled for the same time.

Accordingly, the hearing in the above-captioned matter should be rescheduled

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing on the above-captioned matter shall
2 commence on **May 20, 2004**, at **1:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's
3 offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

5 February 25, 2004 are still in effect.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule is still in effect.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
8 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
