PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 24, 2004, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution, for Administrative Penalties, and For Other Affirmative Action ("Notice") against Mee Diamond & Jewelry, Inc. and Christopher Mee ("Respondents") in which the Division alleged that Respondents have engaged in acts, practices, and transactions that constitute violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of stock and investment contracts.

On April 2, 2004, Respondents, through their attorney, filed a Notice of Appearance and Request for Hearing.

On April 8, 2004, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on May 24, 2004.

On May 17, 2004, Respondents filed a Motion to Continue ("Motion") the pre-hearing due to a scheduling conflict. The Division does not oppose the Motion, and will attempt to resolve the issues raised in the Notice against Respondents in the interim.

Accordingly, the Respondents' Motion should be granted and the pre-hearing conference

1 should be continued.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Respondents' Motion to Continue is hereby granted.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the pre-hearing conference shall be continued from May
4 24, 2004 at 9:00 a.m. to July 8, 2004 at 2:00 p.m. at the Commission's office, 1200 W. Washington,
5 Phoenix, Arizona.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
7 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


