
Dear Marc:

I spoke with Marc Cooper, who is counsel for the MBC's receiver, early this afternoon.

A hearing begins June 10, 2004 on the ex parte receivership the SEC obtained. If the principals of the company are successful in having MBC returned to them, our October and November dates may be needed for the MBC proceeding. On the other hand, if the receivership is kept in place, there is a probability (and that is my analysis) that those dates may become available for the *Yucatan* matter.

I will call Mr. Cooper's office the week of June 14, 2004 to see if the Court has made a decision.
