NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO PROVIDE EXTENDED AREA SERVICE TO PROVIDE EXTENDED TELEPHONE SERVICE

Midvale Telephone Exchange, Inc. ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to provide Extended Area Service in Yavapai County, Arizona.

The application report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the applicant are available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at Applicant's address.

Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 7, 2004. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record. The motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the company, a shareholder of the company, a competitor, etc.)
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

A.A.C. R 14-3-105 governs the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement. The hearing is scheduled to commence on **June 14, 2004 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.
