PUBLIC NOTICE OF FILING BY ACTEL INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS, INC. TO PROVIDE COMPETITIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES
On August 22, 2000, Actel Integrated Communications, Inc. ("Actel") filed an application and petition with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive long distance telecommunications services throughout the State of Arizona at the rates and terms specified in the petition filed with the application. The Commission's application and petition is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Arizona Corporation Commission, Phoenix, Arizona at 100 West Washington Street, and at Actel Integrated Communications, Inc., 450 Laurel Street, Bank One Center, Tower One, Suite 2000, Scottsdale, Arizona. Interested persons shall have twenty (20) days from the publication of this notice to file a motion to intervene and petition. The law provides for an open public hearing at which interested parties may be heard. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled to intervene and petition to intervene. Persons who intervene must file a motion to intervene within twenty (20) days from the date of publication of this notice. This motion should be sent to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, as a minimum, shall contain the following:
1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.
A. A. C. C. 2-1-2-1-2 shall govern the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. No intervenor who intervenes shall preclude any interested party or party appearing at the hearing and entitles a intervenor to file a motion to intervene. 
