) **EXTEND TIME CLOCK**

Staff of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Staff") hereby moves to toll the time clock in the above mentioned docket for the following reasons set forth herein:

On May 1, 2000, Mountain Glen Water Services, Inc. ("Mountain Glen Water") filed an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide water service for property located in Navajo County, Arizona. This certificated area incorporates the CC&N previously granted to the George Papa Water Company ("Papa Water") in Decision No. 34647 (July 10, 1963).

On February 23, 2000, Mr. & Mrs. William Parker purchased the assets of Papa Water at a Public Auction Sale pursuant to A.R.S. § 42-1201 et seq.

On June 9, 2000, the Hearing Division issued a Procedural Order setting this case for hearing on September 20, 2000.

Further, Staff was ordered to file a Staff report in this docket by September 1, 2000.


On July 18, 2000, the Commission postponed the rate application filed by Papa Water assigned as Docket Number W-01894A-00-0007 and W-01894A-00-0008 until after the redemption date on or about September 12, 2000. On August 23, 2000, the time for redemption by Mr. Papa lapses pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-1282, and the Parkers take title to the Papa Water assets.

On August 21, 2000, Ms. Parker requested that the time clock rule in this docket be tolled so that the new rates set for Papa Water at the September 12, 2000 Open Meeting can be incorporated into the tariff filed by Mountain Glen Water (See exhibit A attached hereto).

1 Staff would support Ms. Parkers request that the time clock be tolled for a period of 30 days
2 additional time to allow Staff to incorporate these new rates into the Staff Report to be due on or
3 about October 1, 2000.

4 Staff would further recommend that the hearing in this matter be rescheduled to
5 accommodate this 30 day extension period.
