

NOTICE OF APPLICATION OF THE PHONE COMPANY MANAGEMENT GROUP, LLC d/b/a THE PHONE COMPANY OF ARIZONA FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF FACILITIES BASED AND RESOLD LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES
 Docket No. T-03889-A-02-0578
 The Phone Company Management Group, LLC d/b/a The Phone Company of Arizona ("Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an Application for Discontinuance of Facilities Based and Resold Local Exchange Telecommunications Services. The Applicant is discontinuing service because it has sold its customer base to DMJ Communications, Inc. ("DMJ"). Customers of the Applicant will become the customers of DMJ, after 90 days customer notice, unless they take direct action to change to another alternative telecommunications company in the 90 day notice period. Telecommunications customers have the right to choose an alternative telecommunications carrier at any time.

This Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed within 30 days of the publication of this notice. A.A.C. R14-3-105 shall govern the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf.


