PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about February 19, 1999, U S WEST Communications, Inc. ("U S WEST") propounded on interested Competitive Local Exchange Carriers a set of Data Requests. Objections were filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") by the following parties on the following dates:

ACI Corp. dba Accelerated Connections, Inc. ("ACI")	March 3, 1999

On March 16, 1999, U S WEST filed a Motion to Compel Responses by Various Intervenors to U S WEST's First Set of Data Requests, and a Supplemental Memorandum regarding the Relevance of Individual Data Requests. On March 17, 1999, AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., Teleport Communications Group, Inc. and TCG-Phoenix (collectively "AT&T"), MCIW, Cox, e-spire™, Sprint, ELI, GST, NEXTLINK, ACI, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"), the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") and U S WEST, participated in a telephonic procedural conference to establish dates for responses to U S WEST's Motion and oral argument.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties shall meet and confer regarding the outstanding discovery by the end of business on Monday, March 22, 1999.


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on or before 4:00 p.m. on March 23, 1999, the parties shall  
2 have reviewed the data requests, and provide revised requests or supplemental responses, as  
3 appropriate, in light of the Commission's March 2, 1999 Procedural Order.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervenors and interested parties shall file any responses to  
5 U S WEST's Motion, with copies to be received by U S WEST and the Hearing Division, on or  
6 before 4:00 p.m. on March 26, 1999.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that U S WEST shall file any reply to its Motion, with copies to  
8 be received by intervenors and interested parties and the Hearing Division, on or before 9:00 a.m. on  
9 March 31, 1999.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Oral Argument on U S WEST's Motion shall be held on  
11 April 2, 1999, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix,  
12 Arizona. Parties desiring to participate telephonically shall notify the Hearing Division on or before  
13 April 1, 1999, at 10:00 a.m.<sup>1</sup>
