

**MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION**

U S WEST respectfully submits this Motion for Clarification of the Commission's March 2, 1999 Order to set a schedule for briefing and deciding motions to compel promptly which is necessary to achieve the 90-day timeframe for this matter.

**INTRODUCTION**

U S WEST hereby moves the Commission for an Order clarifying its March 2, 1999 Procedural Order to ensure that motions to compel discovery are heard and decided in a timely manner. Clearly, that is the intent of the present Procedural Order, which states that "in the alternative to filing a written motion to compel discovery, any party seeking discovery may telephonically contact the Commission's hearing Division" and a "hearing will be convened as soon as practicable." U S WEST supports all parties' ability to raise discrete issues telephonically. Although an informal telephonic procedure is adequate for most discovery disputes, U S WEST's experience in 271 dockets is that intervenors object to virtually every
