
Pursuant to our telephone conversation today, this is to advise you that

I am in receipt of US West's *Reply to Intervenors' Responses to US West's Motion to Compel Responses to US West's First Set of Data Requests*. In your Response, you make no mention of the agreement reached between US West and the Telecommunications Resellers Association (TRA) regarding several of US West's Data Requests.


As you know, on Monday, March 22, 1999, during our telephonic discovery conference, you stated that Data Requests Nos. 2 and 16 through 41 were not applicable to TRA due to its status as a trade association. You advised me that TRA had no obligation to respond to the aforementioned data requests. As to the remainder of the data requests, we agreed that supplemental responses would be faxed and mailed to your office on Wednesday, March 24, 1999. On Wednesday, March 24, 1999, Supplemental Responses of the Telecommunications Resellers Association to US West's Data Requests Nos. 1 and 3 through 15 were faxed and mailed, via overnight delivery, to your office. Supplemental documentation was produced on Friday, March 26, 1999.

TRA has now produced all information in its possession which would be responsive to Data Requests Nos. 1 and 3 through 15. Yet US West continues to harass TRA, pursuing its motion to compel responses to *all* data requests against all parties, including TRA. If US West has changed its position, and now wants to impose upon TRA an obligation to answer the remaining data requests, I would appreciate being so advised. Otherwise, it is our expectation that you will withdraw your motion to compel as against TRA at once.

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
