PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On May 24, 2004, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 66994 in the above-captioned matter. As part of the Decision, the Commission ordered that a public comment hearing be scheduled regarding the proposed rule making to amend transportation rules A.A.C.
