PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 15, 1996, National Accounts, Inc. ("National" or "Applicant") filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold intrastate telecommunications services, except local exchange service, within the State of Arizona. The Applicant is required to publish notice of its filing in newspapers in all counties where service is to be provided. The record indicates that the Applicant filed Affidavits of Publication with the Commission on August 26, 1996.

On January 17, 2001, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.

The time frame for processing this application shall be April 30, 2001.

Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the timeframe for processing the application shall be April 30, 2001.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105


1 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before February 16, 2001.

3 Report or a request that a hearing be set by **12 noon** on February 16, 2001.

7 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


