



On November 22, and December 13, 2002, Arizona-American Water Company, Inc. ("Arizona-American" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") applications in the above-captioned dockets for rate increases in the above-stated water and wastewater districts. The actual percentage rate increases requested by the Applicant will vary depending upon the type and quantity of service provided. The proposed monthly increase for an average residential customer in the Sun City West water and wastewater district would be approximately 44.31% (phased in over two years – 40.00% in year one and 4.31% in year two) in water rates and 55.60% (phased in over two years – 40.00% in year one and 15.60% in year two) in wastewater rates. Copies of the application and proposed tariffs are available at the Applicant's Offices, 15626 N. Del Webb Blvd, Sun City, Arizona and the Commission's offices for public inspection during regular business hours.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning October 14, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Arizona-American or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum shall contain the following<sup>1</sup>:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the Arizona-American, a stockholder of Arizona-American, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Arizona-American or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 1, 2003. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. 





On November 22, and December 13, 2002, Arizona-American Water Company, Inc. ("Arizona-American" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") applications in the above-captioned dockets for rate increases in the above-stated water and wastewater districts. The actual percentage rate increases requested by the Applicant will vary depending upon the type and quantity of service provided. The proposed monthly increase for an average residential customer in the Anthem water district and the Anthem/Agua Fria wastewater district would be approximately 16.59% in the Anthem water district and 51.50% (phased in over two years – 40.00% in year one and 11.50% in year two) in the Anthem/Agua Fria wastewater district. Copies of the application and proposed tariffs are available at the Applicant's Offices, 15626 N. Del Webb Boulevard, Sun City, Arizona and the Commission's offices for public inspection during regular business hours.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning October 14, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Intervention shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, which motion should be sent to Arizona-American or its counsel and to all parties of record, and which, at the minimum shall contain the following<sup>1</sup>:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of the Arizona-American, a stockholder of Arizona-American, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Arizona-American or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 1, 2003. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.
