REPORT**


By Procedural Order dated February 12, 2003, Staff was required to file a status report discussing the addressing of issues pertinent to this case in the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order ("TRO"). The TRO was released on August 21, 2003. Staff filed its status report on September 5, 2003. In its report Staff recommended that parties be given 30 days to submit their interpretation of the TRO, and that parties be given 14 days to file their replies. Staff also noted that Cox may at some point determine that it has no remaining concerns related to this docket and that this docket should then be closed.

In response to Staff's Status Report, AT&T responds that prior to parties being required to file their interpretation of the TRO, Cox should be required to notify the Commission if its concerns have been addressed. AT&T notes that if Cox's concerns have been met this docket would be closed. As a result, parties' interpretation of the TRO would be moot. AT&T recommends that Cox first explain its proposals and concerns, if any remain, and then the parties would have 30 days to respond to Staff's questions and 14 days to file rebuttal comments. Staff does not object to AT&T's
