PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated December 4, 2002, the Hearing Division granted Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Utility Division Staff's ("Staff") request to extend the time to file its Staff Report in the above-captioned matter until January 31, 2003.

On January 30, 2003, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff states that the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") is considering some of the same issues being investigated in this docket as part of the FCC's Triennial Review of Unbundled Network Elements. Cox Telecom Arizona LLC ("Cox") has requested that the FCC address issues related to inside wire sub-loop access, and has indicated to Staff that if the FCC does not find in Cox's favor it may reconsider its position in this docket. Staff requests that the filing date of its Recommendations and Staff Report be extended until sometime after the FCC has released its Review and the parties have had an opportunity to analyze it. Staff states that Cox has indicated to Staff that it does not oppose the extension.


Staff states it is uncertain whether the FCC will complete its Review by the February 20, 2003 deadline, and it is likely the deadline will be extended. Therefore, Staff suggests that the Hearing Division set a hearing sometime after the FCC files its Review or order Staff to file its Staff Report no earlier than April 21, 2003.

The requested extension is reasonable and will not prejudice any party.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that within 15 days of the FCC filing its Triennial Review

1 Staff shall file a status report briefly stating the issues pertinent to this docket that were addressed by
2 the FCC and containing Staff's procedural recommendations for this docket.


