ACC National Long Distance Corp. ("ANLDC") hereby seeks to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"). ANLDC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of AT&T Corp.

1. On February 26, 1997, ANLDC filed an application for a CC&N to provide resold telecommunications services in the State of Arizona.

2. By Decision No. 60774, docketed on April 8, 1998, the Commission granted the application of ANLDC to provide competitive interLATA and intraLATA resold telecommunications services, except local exchange service.

3. ANLDC now asks, through this application, that the Commission cancel its CC&N. Going forward the service provided by ANLDC will be provided by its sister affiliate

AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., also a wholly owned subsidiary of AT&T Corp.

4. The only service ANLDC currently offers is dial-around service under the name "Lucky Dog" that can be accessed by dialing the 10-10-345 access code. The dial-around service allows a consumer to choose which carrier to use for a long-distance call simply by pressing specific digits before making the call. For "Lucky Dog," the dial-around number is 10-10-345. Charges for calls made using 10-10-345 are billed to the customer through his or her local telephone company.

5. The service is provided on a per-use basis and therefore there are no pre-existing or pre-subscribed customers to notify regarding cancellation of this CC&N. A general notice of the application to discontinue ANLDC's CC&N will be published in the print media statewide within 20 days of this application. Even after the CC&N is cancelled, customers using 10-10-345 will be able to complete dial-around calls, with service provided by AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. under the name "Lucky Dog."

6. ANLDC has not collected any deposits from customers.

7. In Arizona, the 10-10-XXX dial-around service is also provided by other carriers, such as Qwest (10-10-432) and Telecom USA (MCI) (10-10-220), Excel (10-10-497), Startec (10-10-719), and Var Tec (10-10-811 and 10-10-636).

8. ANLDC will provide notice of the application in the *Arizona Republic* within 20 days of filing the application.


9. ANLDC will cancel its tariff on one day's notice immediately upon approval of this application.

10. On August 25, 2004, AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. filed a tariff to provide 10-10-345 service under the Lucky Dog name. The tariff became effective September 24, 2004. Customers who choose to use the Lucky Dog service will be served by AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. AT&T seeks to cancel the ANLDC CC&N to reduce the number of corporate entities providing the same or similar services.

Now, therefore, ANLDC requests that the Commission: 1) cancel the CC&N of ANLDC, 2) approve the cancellation of ANLDC's tariffs on one day's notice to the Commission after ANLDC's application is granted, and 3) approve ANLDC's application without hearing.
