PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 23, 2004, Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPKO") and Southwest Transmission Cooperative, Inc. ("SWTC") (collectively "Applicants") filed Applications for Rate Increases.

By Procedural Order dated September 15, 2004, the Hearing Division set these matters for hearing and established the guidelines to govern the conduct of the proceeding. One of the provision so the September 15, 2004 Procedural Order was the form of notice.

On October 13, 2004, the Applicants filed a Request for Amendment to the Procedural Order requesting a modification of the size of type required on the notices to be published. The Applicants provided samples of the appearance of the notice as ordered and with the requested change. Applicant's arguments for the smaller type size for published notices are well founded. The notice remains prominent and easy to read under Applicants' requested changes.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the September 15, 2004 Procedural Order is modified to provide that (1) the type specifications for the published Notice be changed to 14-point bold type for the heading and 9-point regular type for the body and (2) the Notice to be included in any newsletters published by the member distribution cooperatives be sized to fit on one full page of the newsletter.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the September 15, 2004 Procedural
2 Order shall remain in effect.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
4 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


