15 Utility Source, L.L.C. (the "Company"), pursuant to A.R.C.P. 42(a) and A.A.C. R14-3-  
16 109(H), hereby files this Motion to Consolidate the subject Dockets for the reasons stated herein.

17 1. On January 30, 2004, the Company filed an Application in the above referenced  
18 Docket for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to serve certain areas within  
19 Coconino County, Arizona

20 2. On that same day the Company filed an Application for Authority to Issue Promissory  
21 Note(s) and Other Evidences of Indebtedness associated with the plant to be utilized in the  
22 requested CC&N Area, in which the Company indicated that a Motion to Consolidate that

1 Application with the CC&N Application would be filed upon Sufficiency of the CC&N  
2 Application. The CC&N Application was declared Sufficient on July 20, 2004.


3 3. On July 23, 2004, the Hearing Division issued a Procedural Order indicating that the  
4 two Applications should be consolidated on or before August 9, 2004, or that the Applications  
5 would be processed independently.

6 4. The Company is of the opinion that both Applications will consider related law and  
7 facts, have the same witnesses, and are so inter-related that these matters should be consolidated  
8 for hearing and consideration.

9 WHEREFORE, Utility Source, L.L.C. respectfully requests that the Administrative Law  
10 Judge consolidate these matters for purposes of hearing and consideration and issue a Procedural  
11 Order to that effect including the form of Notice required.
