

15 Procedural Order ("Order") to require that any party filing a  
16 motion, or a response thereto, effect service via hand delivery

18 This revision is needed to judiciously implement the other  
19 provisions of the Order. The Order requires that all responses  
20 to motions or replies be filed within five days of the filing  
21 date of the motion or response to the motion, respectively. It

23 ruled upon by the Commission within 10 days of the filing date of  
24 the motion shall be deemed denied. However, if service of a  
25 motion or response to a motion is effected by mail, a party

2 will be limited in, or prevented from, submitting its responsive  
3 filing in accordance with the Order.


4 Wherefore, USWC requests that the Hearing Officer revise the
