Appeal for Lower Telephone Rates for Non-Profit Organizations

I am the Executive Director of the CHAI FOUNDATION, a 501(C)(3) non-profit organization that underwrites medical grants.

Our current grantee is a world-class cancer research physician who we believe has made one of the most important and exciting non-toxic, broad-spectrum cancer treatment breakthroughs to date.

The CHAI Foundation needs every dollar possible to go into the completion of this breakthrough research for all our sakes. One way is by saving money where we can.

Currently, there are only two available rate classes for local telephone service: Business and Residential. Realistically, there is little if any difference between the services.

There is, however, a substantial price difference. Business rates are nearly twice as high as residential rates.

Non-profits such as ourselves are **NOT a profit-making business**, and should not be charged as though we were.

We ask you to consider the position of non-profits in this matter, and require QWEST to adopt another Rate Class that will give non-profits, like the CHAI Foundation, a more equitable telephone rate than that of a traditional for-profit business.

Also, as local telephone competition increases in Arizona, I ask you to urge these competitors to adopt a similar rate classification.
