The attached tariff pages are being filed in compliance with Decision No. 63487 and Sections 2(b)(vi) and 3(d) of the Price Cap Plan approved by the Commission on March 30, 2001. The Price Cap Plan requires Qwest to adjust its Basket 1 rates in accordance with a formula that computes the difference between the rate of inflation and the Company's productivity during the past year. Qwest has applied this formula and is reducing its Basket 1 rates by a total of \$ 14.4 million on an annual basis, effective April 1, 2002. In order to achieve this reduction, Qwest is changing the following rates:

- Residence and Business Listings. Qwest is eliminating the non-recurring charge associated with these services. Residence customers currently pay \$8.50 for each listing and business customers pay \$22.50.
- Residence and Business Custom Calling Features. Qwest is also eliminating the non-recurring charge for adding additional features. The current non-recurring rate is \$13.00.
- Business Basic Service. We are reducing the monthly recurring rate for basic business service by \$.98 and the non-recurring rate by \$6.00. The current rates are \$32.78 recurring and \$56.00 non-recurring. The new rates will be \$31.80 and \$50.00, respectively.
- Digital Switched Service (DSS) and Uniform Access Solution (UAS). Qwest is reducing the trunk rates for DSS connections by an average of 11% and UAS connections by an average of 9%.

Section 3(d) of the Price Cap Plan also requires Qwest to reduce its switched access rates in Basket 2 by \$5.0 million on an annual basis. In order to accomplish this, Qwest is reducing the Carrier Common Line rate as follows:

Although not required to do so as part of the Price Cap Plan, Qwest is also reducing its Flat PAL rates in Basket 2 to coincide with the decrease to its basic business rates in Basket 1. The new monthly Flat PAL rate will be \$31.80. Qwest is also reducing the non-recurring rate from \$56.00 to \$50.00 for all types of PAL lines, consistent with the non-recurring rate reduction on basic business lines in Basket 1.

These pages have been prepared with an effective date of April 1, 2002, as required by Section 2(b)(iii) of the Price Cap Plan. Qwest met with the Utilities Division Staff on March 25<sup>th</sup> to review the details of this filing and to provide additional information on the price cap formula. In addition, Qwest has provided Staff with a detailed spreadsheet that documents the changes included in this filing.
