11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
13 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. On August 30, 2000, University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat ("Applicant")
16 filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity
17 ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in the State of Arizona.

18 2. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT
19 providers were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

20 3. Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992) adopted A.A.C. R14-2-901 through R14-2-909 to
21 regulate COPT providers.

22 4. Decision No. 58535 (February 14, 1994) adopted a Generic Tariff that establishes
23 rates and minimum service standards applicable to COPT service.

24 5. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT
25 Certificates without a hearing.

26 6. Applicant has requested that a Certificate be granted and has indicated that it will
27 provide COPT service pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions specified in the Generic COPT
28 Tariff.

2 5. Staff's recommendations in Findings of Fact No. 12 and 13 are reasonable and should
3 be adopted.

4 **ORDER**

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J.
6 Laundromat for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide customer-owned pay
7 telephone service shall be, and is hereby, approved, conditioned upon University Auto Plaza, Inc.
8 d/b/a A.J. Laundromat filing a customer information placard approved by the Director of the Utilities
9 Division for compliance with the requirements of the Generic COPT Tariff within 60 days of the
10 effective date of this Decision.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat shall
12 comply with the terms of the Generic COPT Tariff, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat shall file
14 the following FVRB information within 18 months of the date that it first provides service. The
15 FVRB shall include a dollar amount representing the total revenue for the first twelve months of
16 telecommunications service provided to Arizona customers by University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J.
17 Laundromat following certification, adjusted to reflect the maximum rates that University Auto
18 Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat requests in its tariff. This adjusted total revenue figure could be
19 calculated as the number of units sold for all services offered times the maximum charge per unit.
20 University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat shall also file FVRB information detailing the
21 total actual operating expenses for the first twelve months of telecommunications service provided to
22 Arizona customers by University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat following certification.
23 University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat shall also file FVRB information which includes a
24 description and value of all assets, including plant, equipment, and office supplies to be used to
25 provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers for the first twelve months following
26 University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat's certification.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 90 days of the effective date of this Decision,
2 University Auto Plaza, Inc. d/b/a A.J. Laundromat shall notify the Compliance Section of the Arizona
3 Corporation Commission of the date that it will begin or has begun providing service to Arizona
4 customers.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
