

PROCEDURAL ORDER

10 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

11 On March 1, 1996, Starlink Communications, LLC ("Starlink" or "Applicant") filed with  
12 Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a  
13 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold intrastate  
14 telecommunications services, except local exchange service, within the State of Arizona.

15 On April 23, 1996, Starlink filed Affidavits of Publication indicating compliance with the  
16 Commission's notice requirements.

17 On January 5, 2001, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report  
18 in this matter.

19 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to  
20 provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested  
21 by any party.

22 The time frame for processing this application shall be extended to April 30, 2001.

23 Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern  
24 the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

25 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the timeframe for processing the application shall be  
26 April 30, 2001.

27 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Starlink shall file written exceptions, if any, to the Staff  
28 Report or a request that a hearing be set by 12 noon on February 9, 2001.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105,  
2 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **12 noon** on February 9, 2001.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
4 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive  
6 any portion of this Procedural Order by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


