MOTION TO EXTEND HEARING FOR DOCKET NO. W-04264A-04-0438


On October 19, 2004 Arizona Water Company (AWC) filed a motion to consolidate the two rival Certificate of Convenience and Necessity applications that were submitted in order to provide water to the Sandia master-planned community. In that motion, AWC requested that its application to extend its existing CC&N be consolidated with the rival application of Woodruff Water Company for a new CC&N. (Please note that the Woodruff application is a consolidation between Docket No. W-04264A-04-0438 and Docket No. SW-04265A-04-0439. These cases have been consolidated under Docket No. W-04264A-04-0438.)

Staff notes that it has no objection to the motion to consolidate. But regardless of consolidation, the issues raised by Arizona Water Company add new elements to the Woodruff case. Staff will require additional time to conduct discovery and consider these new issues. Accordingly, Staff asks that the current procedural schedule in the Woodruff case (Docket No. W-04264A-04-

1 0438) be vacated and a new schedule be established.

2 If in fact the motion to consolidate is granted, the Legal Division would request that the
3 November 12, 2004 deadline for the Woodruff staff report be vacated and extended. The time
4 extension is requested so that both of these cases can be put on the same timeline, thus allowing both
5 CC&N applications to be reviewed and discussed concurrently.
