PROCEDURAL ORDER

Respondents.

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 7, 2004, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Fountain Capital Management, LLC ("FCM"), Intergrowth Financial Group ("IFG"), Richard A. Fandrich, David A. and Deborah Fazio, Donald and Helen Abernathy, Stephen A. and Jane Doe Hiltbrand and

1 Roger Alvin Sande (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of
2 the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of
3 viatical contracts and investment contracts.

4 All Respondents have been duly served with a copy of the Notice except Donald and Helen
5 Abernathy who have moved from Arizona.

6 On May 21, 2004, requests for hearing were filed for FCM, David A. and Deborah Fazio.

7 On May 24, 2004, a request for hearing was filed for Stephen A. and Cheryl J. Hiltbrand.

8 On June 7, 2004, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled for June 30,
9 2004.

10 On June 9, 2004, counsel for FCM and the Fazio Respondents filed a Motion for Extension of
11 Time to File Answer ("Extension Motion") until June 18, 2004. The Extension Motion indicated that
12 the Division did not oppose it.

13 On June 11, 2004, counsel for the Hiltbrands filed their Answer and demanded a jury trial.

14 On June 15, 2004, by Procedural Order, the Extension Motion was granted.

15 On June 18, 2004, an Answer was filed for FCM and the Fazios.

16 On June 30, 2004, a pre-hearing conference was held as scheduled earlier. The Division,
17 FCM, the Fazios and the Hiltbrands were represented by counsel. The Division and counsel who
18 were present for the Respondents, FCM, the Fazios and Hiltbrands agreed that another pre-hearing
19 conference should be scheduled on August 10, 2004, while a possible resolution of the allegations
20 raised in the Notice was discussed.

21 On July 1, 2004, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled for August 10,
22 2004.

23 On August 10, 2004, at the pre-hearing conference, the Division, FCM, the Fazios and the
24 Hiltbrands were represented by counsel. The parties agreed to schedule a hearing starting on
25 November 8, 2004, since a settlement had not been reached.

26 On August 10, 2004, by Procedural Order, the hearing was scheduled to commence on
27 November 8, 2004 and copies of the witness lists and exhibits were to be exchanged by October 15,
28 2004.

1 On October 18, 2004, the Division, FCM, the Fazios and the Hiltbrands filed a stipulation to
2 extend the date for exchanging copies of witness lists and exhibits to October 22, 2004.

3 On October 20, 2004, by Procedural Order, the parties' stipulation was approved.

4 On November 4, 2004, the Division telephonically requested that the hearing scheduled on
5 November 8, 2004, be vacated because the FCM, Fazio and Hiltbrand Respondents had signed
6 Consent Orders to be submitted to the Commission for approval at Open Meeting.

7 Accordingly, the hearing date should be vacated.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for November 8, 2004, is hereby
9 vacated pending approval by the Commission of Respondents' Consent Orders.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall request the proceeding be rescheduled, if
11 necessary.


