PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 13, 2000, Comm South Companies, Inc. ("Comm South" or "Applicant") filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona.

On January 5, 2001, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter.

On January 11, 2001, Comm South filed Affidavits of Publication indicating compliance with the Commission's notice requirements.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.

The time frame for processing this application expires on July 13, 2001.

Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Comm South shall file written exceptions, if any, to the Staff Report or a request that a hearing be set by **12 noon** on February 9, 2001.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before **12 noon** on February 9, 2001.
