Tacna Water Company has filed with the Corporation Commission Utilities Division an application for authority for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity To provide water service. Our records indicate that you are either currently a customer of Tacna Water Company or a property owner in proposed extension area. If the application is granted Tacna Water Company would be exclusive provider of water service to the proposed area. Tacna Water Company will be required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions established by the commission. The granting of the application would not necessarily prohibit an individual from providing service to themselves from individually owned facilities on their property. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix at 1200 West Washington Street, and at Tacna Water Company 4743 E 30th Place (In Sun-state office) Yuma Az.

The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter. As a property owner, or customer, you may be entitled to intervene in the proceedings. If you do not want to intervene, you may appear at the hearing and make a statement on your behalf. You may not receive any further notice of the proceeding unless requested by you.
