Dear Mr. Carolin:

Thank you for your letter expressing your views regarding TRICO Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s proposed CC&N extension. Your letter has been placed on file with Docket Control and will become part of the official record in this case.

As you know, this is currently a pending matter that will be scheduled for an Open Meeting before the Commission. However, I have attached a copy of the rule that describes how you can intervene in a case before the Commission. Although the Commission acts like a quasi-judicial body, you do not have to hire an attorney to represent you as an intervener. Further, if you choose not to intervene, you can still voice your concern by writing a letter(s) to be filed in the docket or by appearing at a public comment session, if one is scheduled. I appreciate your correspondence and will consider anything you submit to the docket as we continue with the hearing process. After reviewing the entire record, the Commission will vote to accept, modify or deny the Administrative Law Judge's proposed order at an Open Meeting.
