SECOND
PROCEDURAL ORDER

13 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

14 On July 22, 2004, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation
 15 Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist (T.O.) and Notice of
 16 Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Parklane International Corporation ("PIC") and
 17 Syndicated Gold Depository S.A. ("SGD") (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division
 18 alleged that Respondents had committed multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in
 19 connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

20 Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

21 On September 13, 2004, SGD, through Florida counsel, filed a request for hearing and notice
 22 of appearance ("Request"). SGD's counsel did not submit evidence of admission Pro Hac Vice
 23 ("PHV") in compliance with Rule 33 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and evidence that he
 24 had paid the required filing fees.

25 Accordingly, SGD's Request filed in response to the T.O. and Notice should be held in
 26 abeyance pending SGD's counsel filing a Motion and Consent for Admission Pro Hac Vice ("Motion
 27 PHV") with the Commission which establishes he is in compliance with Rule 33 of the Rules of the
 28 Arizona Supreme Court and evidence that the required filing fees have been paid in a timely fashion.

3 On September 15, 2004, by Procedural Order, SGD's Request was ordered held in abeyance
4 for 60 days from the date of receipt of the Procedural Order by SGD's Florida counsel on September
5 20, 2004. This would allow time for filing the Motion PHV and to comply with the other provisions
6 of Rule 33. Thereafter, a pre-hearing conference would be scheduled.

7 On November 8, 2004, a local attorney entered an appearance as counsel of record for SGD
8 and the Division filed a Request for Postponement for the scheduling of a pre-hearing conference.
9 The Division requested a postponement of the scheduling of a pre-hearing conference because it is
10 negotiating a settlement with SGD. If the parties are unable to reach an agreement, the Division will
11 request a pre-hearing be scheduled.

12 Accordingly, the Division's Request for Postponement is reasonable and a pre-hearing will
13 not be scheduled unless requested by the Division.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Request for Postponement by the Division is hereby
15 granted.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the filing of a Motion to Schedule by the Division, a
17 pre-hearing conference will be scheduled.


