
- 25 1. Hon. Tom Rankin – Mayor of Florence, Arizona.

1 The Hon. Tom Rankin is the Mayor of the Town of Florence. Mayor Rankin is expected to  
2 testify concerning Resolution 896-04, in favor of the "Preferred Alignment", which was passed by  
3 the Town of Florence on August 9, 2004. Mayor Rankin will also discuss the future land use and  
4 growth plans of the Town and is expected to testify that from Florence's perspective, the alignment  
5 along Christiansen Road is superior to the eastern alignment. He will explain why the Town feels it  
6 is important to protect its major residential growth areas and future development projects from the  
7 power lines and why the area near Christiansen Road is more compatible with the future power  
8 lines. Specifically, the Christiansen Road alignment is closer to the uninhabited areas along the  
9 eastern boundary of the Gila River Indian Community and will therefore have the least impact upon  
10 the major developments planned for the west end of the Town of Florence. Although some  
11 landowners have planned to develop communities in this alignment of the power line, they are areas  
12 which are comparatively less amenable to high density development due to their topography; it will  
13 also follow a railway which is more compatible with the power line use; and it is farther from the  
14 Town core.



RESOLUTION NO. 896-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF FLORENCE  
EXPRESSING THE TOWN'S PREFERENCE  
FOR THE SITING OF POWER LINES

WHEREAS, The Town of Florence has been shown a variety of power line siting alternatives for the Salt River Project ("SRP") Southeast Valley/ BOB Line Siting Project; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Florence prefers one of the proposed line siting alternatives above all others and desires to make this preference known in an official proceeding; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Florence's preferred line siting alternative is specifically identified as "Preferred Alignment" and can generally be described as the alternative that approximately sites the lines running north along Christensen Road; and

WHEREAS, the preferred siting is desirable above all others because the other proposed sitings are not conducive to or compatible with, the existing and planned residential developments in the Town of Florence and its' Planning Area that would be directly and significantly impacted if such sitings were selected; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council have considered said alternatives and find that it is wise, expedient, necessary and advisable that the siting identified as "Preferred Alignment" be utilized by SRP and that all other proposed siting configurations be rejected; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Florence, State of Arizona, that the Town of Florence prefers and requests the utilization of the particular line siting identified herein and requests that SRP utilize the preferred siting in conjunction with its Southeast Valley/ BOB Line Siting Project.

THIS RESOLUTION PASSED AND ADOPTED this 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2004, at a meeting duly called by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Florence.


