To The Arizona Corporation Commission:

C.T.I. formally requests a Motion of Intervention from the A.C.C. on its property at 2255 W. Oatman Road, Golden Valley AZ. 86413, phone number 928-718-1141. C.T.I also requests an emergency meeting by the A.C.C. in order to establish electrical service as soon as possible.

I am the Vice President of Western Operations for C.T.I. at 2255 W. Oatman Road, Golden Valley. As C.T.I.'s representative at this location, my interest in this matter is to establish electrical power on the property for C.T.I. so it can proceed with the construction of its facility and conduct its business.

C.T.I. has been without power since requesting power on May 24, 2004. To date C.T.I has paid Mohave Electric Cooperative \$5000.00 for service, and has received nothing in return, because of a territory dispute between Mohave Electric Cooperative, and Unisource Energy. Unisource Energy has offered to enter into an agreement with Mohave Electric Cooperative to provide C.T.I. with power, under a borderline agreement, which Mohave Electric has refused to do. In addition the building which was formally North Star Steel, still has power which was all the same properties. C.T.I. has had considerable expense, having to acquire a generator and the price of fuel to run the generator, in order to provide electric to our mobile office. For these reasons C.T.I. is filling this formal motion, and ask respectfully for an emergency meeting to rectify the problem.
