R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before February 24, 2005. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record. The motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. A.A.C. R14-3-105 governs the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement for the record of the proceeding. The hearing is scheduled to commence on March 10, 2005 at 1:30 p.m. at the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.




