PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 1, 2005, Qwest Corporation filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule in the above-captioned dockets. On the same date, Qwest filed a notice in the docket that requested Commission Utilities Division Staff to schedule a series of meetings for the purpose of settlement discussions. Qwest believes it would be a waste of resources for the parties to proceed with the hearing while settlement negotiations are on-going.

At a February 2, 2005 Procedural Conference, the parties discussed Qwest's proposal. MCI, Inc., Time Warner and the Department of Defense were opposed to delaying the hearing. Staff, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"), Arizona Utility Investors Association ("AUIA") and Cox Telecom did not oppose a suspension during settlement negotiations.


At the February 2, 2005 Procedural Conference, the Administrative Law Judge verbally suspended the procedural schedule and requested that the parties attempt to reach agreement on a proposed process for settlement discussion. On February 4, 2005, the parties filed a Joint Proposal for Settlement Negotiations. The parties to this docket agreed to participate in settlement conferences that would commence on February 10, 2005, and continue on February 11, 2005, if necessary. They further agreed to hold the next two settlement meetings on February 17, 2004, and February 28, 2005,

1 and recommended that the Administrative Law Judge hold a status conference to ascertain the
2 parties' progress in settlement negotiations, suggesting March 3, 2005 as the date of the first status
3 conference.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a Procedural Conference for the purpose of updating the
5 Commission on the status of settlement discussions, discussing a procedural schedule going forward,
6 and any other procedural issues, shall commence on March 3, 2005, at 10:30 a.m., or as soon
7 thereafter as is practicable, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
10 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
