PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 27, 1997, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 60223 which approved the issuance of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to Johnson Utilities, L.L.C. dba Johnson Utilities Company ("JUC") to provide water and wastewater treatment service in various parts of Pinal County, Arizona. In Decision No. 60223, the Commission ordered JUC to file on January 31st of each following year, beginning in 1998, a Status Report in the form of an accounting for all hook-up fees collected and expended in the prior year.

On February 1, 2005, JUC filed a request for an extension ("Request") until February 4, 2005, to file the Status Report because JUC's accountant could not complete his analysis by January 31, 2005.

On February 2, 2005, JUC filed its annual Status Report which describes the collection of hook-up fess and their disbursement in the prior year.


On February 9, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Memorandum which indicated that JUC has consistently filed the annual Status Report since 1998 in a timely

1 fashion and recommended approval of JUC's request for an extension.

2 Accordingly, JUC's request for an extension should be granted through the date of filing,
3 February 2, 2005.

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Johnson Utilities, L.L.C. dba Johnson Utilities
5 Company is hereby granted a retroactive extension until February 2, 2005, to file its Status Report in
6 the form on an accounting for all hook-up fees collected and expended in the prior year.


