It has come to our attention that the Tariff filed in the subject water rate case Application contains a typographical error. On Schedule H-3, Page 1 of Exhibit A to the Application, and on Sheet No. 8.0 of Exhibit F of that Application, the Late Payment Charge, Per Month indicates the proposed rate is 1.50 %. That is incorrect. The correct proposed charge should be \$10.00 Per Month.

**WATER SERVICE**

I.	Deferred Payment Finance Charge, per month <sup>8</sup>	1.5%
J.	Late Payment Charge, Per Month <sup>9</sup> <sup>10</sup>	\$10.00

<sup>8</sup> Deferred payments for water service are only available if established in connection with deferred payments for wastewater service under PART THREE, III.F of this Tariff.

<sup>9</sup> This charge shall not apply if the customer has arranged for a Deferred Payment Plan.

<sup>10</sup> Bills for utility services are due and payable when rendered. Any payment not received within fifteen (15) days from the date the bill was rendered shall be considered delinquent and subject to the termination policy set forth in the Company's rate tariff. All late payment penalties shall be billed on the customer's next regularly scheduled billing. If the customer fails to pay the late payment penalty by the due date on the next billing, the customer will receive a ten (10) day termination notice. If the customer does not pay the late payment penalty by that date the service will be terminated. Service shall be terminated only for that service for which the customer is delinquent or is in violation. All customers whose service is terminated for failure to pay the late payment penalty are subject to the Company's reconnection charge set forth in the Company's tariff.

- 18 (a) Residential - two times the average bill. Non-residential - two and one-half times the average bill.  
 19 The Company does not normally require a deposit prior to the provision of service. However, in the  
 20 event a customer is disconnected for non-payment, this deposit is required.  
 21 (b) Minimum charge times number of full months disconnected.  
 22 (c) Actual cost of physical disconnection and reconnection (if same customer) and there shall be no  
 23 charge if there is no physical work performed.  
 24 (d) This charge shall not apply if wastewater service is paid with the same NSF check used to pay for  
 25 wastewater service for which a NSF fee is charged.  
 26 (e) Present rates - all hook-up fees in excess of 60 per year to be treated as contributions.  
 27 Proposed rates - all hook-up fees treated as revenues.
