11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
13 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 15 1. Interroute-Retail, Inc. ("IRI" or "Applicant") has a Certificate of Convenience and
16 Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services in
17 the State of Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 61216 (October 29, 1998).
- 18 2. On December 8, 2000, IRI filed with the Commission an application requesting
19 cancellation of the Certificate.
- 20 3. As part of its application, IRI stated that it has notified all of its customers of its
21 discontinuance of services.
- 22 4. Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission may grant the application without a
23 hearing.
- 24 5. On March 23, 2001, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff
25 Report recommending approval of IRI's application for cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience
26 and Necessity without a hearing.
- 27 6. The Staff Report indicates that IRI was ordered not to collect any prepayments,
28 advances, or deposits, and therefore, no customer deposits are at risk.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

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2 1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
3 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

4 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Applicant and the subject matter of the
5 application.

6 3. The cancellation of Applicant's Certificate is in the public interest.

7 4. Staff's recommendation in Findings of Fact No. 5 is reasonable and should be
8 adopted.

ORDER

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10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Interoute-Retail, Inc. for the
11 cancellation of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide competitive resold
12 interexchange telecommunications services shall be, and the same is hereby approved.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
