This notice will inform you that JirehCom Long Distance, Inc. has not met certain compliance requirements ordered by the Commission in the above-referenced Decision. In that Decision, the Commission conditioned approval of the application on JirehCom Long Distance, Inc. filing certain documents with the Commission within a specific time period as described on the attached Compliance Delinquencies Report.

As a result of this non-compliance, the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity did not issue to JirehCom Long Distance, Inc. and is void. If JirehCom Long Distance, Inc. intends to provide service in the future within Arizona, it must either file a new application for a certificate of convenience and necessity or obtain an extension of time to comply from the Commission. If you are requesting an extension of time to comply, your request must be received by the Commission no later than thirty (30) days from the date of this notice. Your request should set forth the reasons why you did not comply with the Commission's Decision and why you should be granted an extension. The Commission will consider your request and issue an Order either granting or denying your request for extension.
