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



NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Arizona Public Service Company for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing the West Valley North Transmission Line and Substation Project ("Project") in Maricopa County, Arizona. The hearing will be held at the Crowne Room, Glendale Civic Center, 5750 W. Glenn Drive, Glendale, Arizona 85301 beginning on January 24, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. and continuing on January 25, 2005, at 9:30 a.m. The hearings will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. Additional hearing days, if necessary, will be noticed in the Project website and the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") website. The Project website is <http://www.siting.apsc.com>. The ACC website is <http://www.cc.state.az.us/utility/electric/linesiting-calendar.htm>.

Public comment will be taken at the beginning of each hearing day. Public comment will also be taken in a special evening session on January 24, 2005 beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Crowne Room, Glendale Civic Center, 5750 W. Glenn Drive, Glendale, Arizona 85301.

The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area, preferred route and any route alternatives on January 28, 2005, or on a future date. The map and itinerary for the tour will be available at the hearings and posted on the Project website. Members of the public may follow the Committee in their own private vehicles. During any tour, the Committee will not discuss or deliberate in any manner concerning the Application.

Generally, the Project, consisting of a 230kV transmission line and two substations, will be located in Maricopa County, beginning at the TS2 Substation (certificated in West Valley - South, Case 122) located in the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 2 West, the preferred route corridor would consist of these segments:

- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 2 miles along Loop 303 from Olive Avenue to Cactus Road. The corridor width would include 2000 feet east and west of the centerline designating Loop 303.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling west for 3 miles along Cactus Road from Loop 303 to the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet north and south of the centerline designating Cactus Road.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 4.5 miles along the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment from Cactus Road to the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet west and 1,000 feet east of the half-section line located east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling west for 1 mile along the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive from the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment to the half-section line west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet north and south of the half-section line located north of Union Hills Drive.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 1 mile along the half-section line west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment from the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive to the proposed TS1 Substation. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet west and 1,000 feet east of the half-section line located west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment.

The proposed TS1 Substation would include up to 10 acres of land located in the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 20, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, approximately at the half-section line north of Beardsley Road.

- A 4,000-foot corridor, bifurcated by the existing 500kV transmission line corridor, traveling west for 5.5 miles along the half-section line north of the Beardsley Road alignment from the TS1 substation to 243rd Avenue. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet north of the line formed by the northernmost towers and 1,000 feet south of the line formed by the southernmost towers that are located within the existing 500kV transmission line corridor.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 1.1 miles along 243rd Avenue from the existing 500kV transmission line corridor to the CAP Canal. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet west and east of the centerline designating 243rd Avenue.

- A 4,000-foot corridor, bifurcated by the existing CAP Canal, traveling west for 6.3 miles along the CAP Canal from 243rd Avenue to 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21, Township 4 North, Range 4 West. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet north of the chain-link fence located on the north side of the CAP Canal and 1,000 feet south of the chain-link fence located on the south side of the CAP Canal.
- A 4,000-foot corridor traveling south for 0.7 mile, located 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, from north of the CAP Canal to 0.50 mile south of the Beardsley Road alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet west and east of a centerline 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21 and 28 and 29, Township 4 North, Range 4 West.

The corridor terminates at the proposed TS5 substation, which would include up to 120 acres in the West ½ of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 4 West.

The Application also sets forth preferred and alternative alignments. A general location map of the Project study area, Applicant's preferred alignment and alternative alignments are set forth below.

More complete maps, along with more detailed textual descriptions of the preferred and alternative alignments are available in the Application itself and on the Project website. The Application, including detailed maps of the proposed Project, is on file with the Docket Control Center of the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Suite 108, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Copies of the Application are also available for inspection at the following locations:

- Maricopa County Library District, Northwest Regional Library, 16089 N. Bullard Ave., Surprise
- Buckeye Public Library, 310 North 6th Street, Buckeye

Depending on the issues raised and the number of intervenors appearing during the hearing, the Committee may deem it appropriate at some point to recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. These dates and places will be posted on the Project and ACC websites. At the discretion of the Committee, such resumed hearing may be held at a date, time and place designated by the Committee or its Chairman.

NOTE: NOTICE OF SUCH RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN. PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.

Each county and municipal government and state agency interested in the proposed Project and desiring to become a party to the proceeding, shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, a notice of its intent to be a party.

Any domestic, non-profit corporation or association, formed in whole or in part to promote conservation of natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is to be located and desiring to become a party to the certification proceeding, shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, a notice of its intent to be a party.


The Committee or its Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings.

The written decision of the Committee shall be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party before the Arizona Corporation Commission must be a party to the certification proceedings before the Committee.

NOTICE OF HEARING

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Sitting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of Arizona Public Service Company for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing the West Valley North Transmission Line and Substation Project ("Project") in Maricopa County, Arizona. The hearing will be held at the Crowme Room, Glendale Civic Center, 5750 W. Glenn Drive, Glendale, Arizona 85301 beginning on January 24, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. and continuing on January 25, 2005, at 9:30 a.m. The hearings will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. Additional hearing days, if necessary, will be noticed in the Project website and the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") website. The Project website is <http://www.sitting.apsc.com>. The ACC website is www.cc.state.az.us/utility/electric/line-sitting-calendar.htm.

Public comment will be taken at the beginning of each hearing day. Public comment will also be taken in a special evening session on January 24, 2005 beginning at 6:30 p.m. at the Crowme Room, Glendale Civic Center, 5750 W. Glenn Drive, Glendale, Arizona 85301.

The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area, preferred route and any route alternatives on January 28, 2005, or on a future date. The map and itinerary for the tour will be available at the hearings and posted on the Project website. Members of the public may follow the Committee in their own private vehicles. During any tour, the Committee will not discuss or deliberate in any manner concerning the Application.

Generally, the Project, consisting of a 230kV transmission line and two substations, will be located in Maricopa County, beginning at the TS2 Substation (certificated in West Valley - South, Case 192) located in the SE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 2 West, the preferred route corridor would consist of

the proposed corridor beginning north for 2 miles along Loop 303 from Olive Avenue to Cactus Road. The corridor width would include 2000 feet east and west of the centerline designating Loop 303.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling west for 3 miles along Cactus Road from Loop 303 to the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet north and south of the centerline designating Cactus Road.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 4.5 miles along the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment from Cactus Road to the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet west and 1,000 feet east of the half-section line located east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling west for 1 mile along the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive from the half-section line east of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment to the half-section line west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet north and south of the half-section line located north of Union Hills Drive.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 1 mile along the half-section line west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment from the half-section line north of Union Hills Drive to the proposed TSI Substation. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet west and 1,000 feet east of the half-section line located west of the 195th Avenue/Jackrabbit Trail alignment.

The proposed TSI Substation would include up to 10 acres of land located in the SE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 20, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, approximately at the half-section line north of Bearslley Road.

• A 4,000-foot corridor, bifurcated by the existing 500kV transmission line corridor, traveling west for 5.5 miles along the half-section line north of the Bearslley Road alignment from the TSI substation to 243rd Avenue. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet north of the line formed by the northernmost towers and 1,000 feet south of the line formed by the southernmost towers that are located within the existing 500kV transmission line corridor.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling north for 1.1 miles along 243rd Avenue from the existing 500kV transmission line corridor to the CAP Canal. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet west and east of the centerline designating 243rd Avenue.

• A 4,000-foot corridor, bifurcated by the existing CAP Canal, traveling west for 6.3 miles along the CAP Canal from 243rd Avenue to 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21, Township 4 North, Range 4 West. The corridor width would include 3,000 feet north of the chain-link fence located on the north side of the CAP Canal and 1,000 feet south of the chain-link fence located on the south side of the CAP Canal.

• A 4,000-foot corridor traveling south for 0.7 mile, located 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, from north of the CAP Canal to 0.50 mile south of the Beardsley Road alignment. The corridor width would include 2,000 feet west and east of a centerline 0.5 mile west of the section line between Sections 20 and 21 and 28 and 29, Township 4 North, Range 4 West.

The corridor terminates at the proposed TS5 substation, which would include up to 120 acres in the West 1/2 of Section 29, Township 4 North, Range 4 West.

The Application also sets forth preferred and alternative alignments. A general location map of the Project study area, Applicant's preferred alignment and alternative alignments are set forth below.

More complete maps, along with more detailed textual descriptions of the preferred and alternative alignments are available in the Application itself and on the Project website. The Application, including detailed maps of the proposed Project, is on file with the Docket Control Center of the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Suite 108, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Copies of the Application are also available for inspection at the following locations:

Depending on the issues raised and the number of intervenors appearing during the hearing, the Committee may deem it appropriate at some point to recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. These dates and places will be posted on the Project and ACC websites. At the discretion of the Committee, such resumed hearing may be held at a date, time and place designated by the Committee or its Chairman.

Each county and municipal government and state agency interested in the proposed Project and desiring to become a party to the proceeding, shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, a notice of its intent to be a party.

Any domestic, non-profit corporation or association, formed in whole or in part to promote conservation of natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups or to promote the orderly development of the area in which the Project is to be located and desiring to become a party to the certification proceeding, shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, file with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, a notice of its intent to be a party.


The Committee or its Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other persons parties to the proceedings.

The written decision of the Committee shall be submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Section 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party before the Arizona Corporation Commission must be a party to the certification proceedings before the Committee.
