PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 23, 2003, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed an application requesting a declaratory order finding that its past and present procedures for bill estimation either are exempt from or comply with the requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-102 and R14-2-1612 ("Application for Declaratory Order").

On September 9, 2004, Avis Read ("Complainant"), on her own behalf and on behalf of a class of customers of APS filed a complaint ("Complaint") against APS.

On November 2, 2004, a Procedural Order was issued consolidating these matters and setting procedural dates.

On January 27, 2005, APS requested a telephonic procedural conference to discuss a procedural issue.

On January 28, 2005, a telephonic procedural conference was held with the parties. APS requested a short suspension of the procedural schedule for one week, in order to allow it and the

1 parties to discuss settlement of these consolidated matters. No party opposed the request, and the
2 request was granted. The procedural conference scheduled for Monday, January 31, 2005 was
3 vacated and the testimony and exhibit filing deadlines suspended. The February 2, 2005 hearing date
4 will be used for taking public comment. A telephonic procedural conference was scheduled for
5 Friday, February 4, 2005 at 1:30 p.m. for an update on the status of discussions.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the pre-hearing conference scheduled for January 31, 2005 is
7 hereby vacated and the testimony and exhibit filing deadlines are suspended.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for February 2, 2005 will be used for
9 taking public comments, commencing at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the
10 Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic procedural conference will be held on
12 February 4, 2005 at 1:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200
13 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
15 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
17 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
